Welcome to another year at Todd Family Fun Farm! This year we have chosen a social studies theme for the fall, “**Travel the USA.**” Our giant corn maze will allow you to “travel” all 50 states and learn about major monuments, state parks, etc. Our mini corn maze is all about the great state of Alaska. We also have several new educational attractions that arrived on the farm over the summer!

Our program is ideal for students in Pre-K through 7th grade. Besides the maze, the classroom topic this year is corn. Students will learn about corn, shell some corn the old fashioned way, and learn what things are made from corn. They will also learn about pigs at the pig race, learn about pumpkins and seeds, feel cotton, and milk a cow.

We’re available to help you plan your day and to work with you to develop related curriculum for your students to use and apply during their visit and/or back in the classroom.
